

Jane Eamon Pieces of Me

There's no denying that life has played a big part of shaping Jane Eamon's new CD, Pieces of Me. With the death of her father and her husband's stroke on Christmas Day, it's a wonder that this album ever saw the light of day.

Eamon had thought she was done with music. She confesses that "I had come to resent it more than just a little and had no real desire to continue." After her husband's stroke and the sudden death of her father, writing seemed the only way she could cope. Songs started appearing and a new album started shaping itself. "I didn't

really think I had another one in me, I was prepared to just write when I could and be done with it." But the songs wouldn't let her be.

Andrew Smith, Lake Studios Kelowna BC, a long-time collaborator, suggested they try recording a few. Over the next few months, nine songs emerged as Pieces of Me. Stripped bare and soulful with vibe and honesty, this album became Eamon's opus. From the soulful, When I Build This House, through the rootsy Songwriters Lament, it showcases the songwriting talents of Eamon and the melodic delivery of her strong alto voice.

You will cry, there's no doubt of that. But by the end, you may just want to listen to it again, and by the second or third listening, you may just find the hope. There is also a limited edition chapbook available with selected poetry, writings and all song lyrics.
